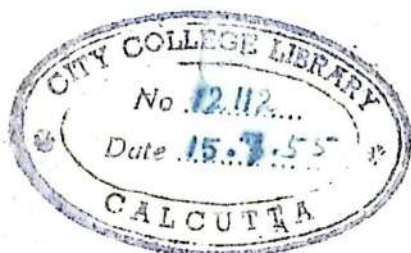

## BRIEF HISTORY

OF

# THE CITY COLLEGE.

*(Reported at the Silver Jubilee of the College,  
held on the 23rd January, 1904.)*

The City College was first started as a High School on the 6th of January 1879, an eventful day in its history which has been fraught in the course of these years with many manifestations of God's Providence and Mercy.

2. The Institution was founded by Mr. A. M. Bose, M. A. Barrister-at-Law, who took upon himself the sole responsibility of meeting its expenses. Pandit Siva Nath Sastri, M. A., the present Principal, and some other veteran educationists associated with Mr. Bose to render to the Institution their best help and joined its tutorial staff. It was opened with the object of educating Indian students of all races and creeds on an improved and comprehensive plan, so that while meeting all the requirements of the University Examination, the Institution would try for the improvement of the character of the boys placed under its charge and the healthful development of all their faculties.

3. In 1881 two years after its establishment the Institution was raised to the F. A. Examination Standard; in 1883 after another two years a Law Department teaching up to the B. L. Standard was added to it; and in 1884 it was ex-

panded to a First-Grade College. The results of the University from the very commencement were highly satisfactory. Its students have headed the B. A. Honour's lists in the whole University in English, History, and Sanskrit; and also the F. A. pass list. On several other occasions they have occupied very high places in the above as well as other subjects and secured competition scholarships of all kinds. In the University M. A. Examination one of its students was first in History and another in Mathematics. Several of the students have passed the M. A. Examination in English, Philosophy, and Science. The first student who has taken his M. A. degree in Geology since the foundation of the Calcutta University was from the City College. The Late Director of Public Instruction Sir Alfred Croft observed in his official report that "the unaided City College of Calcutta occupied a unique and distinguished position in regard to the teaching of Science."

4. The authorities of the College tried to help the education of students by the institution of extra lectures and special periodical examinations. Among others, the following distinguished gentlemen delivered lectures from time to time:—

5. Among the patrons of the College have been Lord Ripon, Viceroy and Governor-General of India. Lord Dufferin, Viceroy and Governor-General of India. Lord Lansdowne, Viceroy and Governor-General of India. Lord Roberts, Commander-in-Chief of India, Sir Augustus Rivers Thompson, Lieutenant Governor of Bengal, Sir St. urt Bayley, Lieutenant Governor of Bengal, Sir Alexander Mackenzi, Lieutenant Governor of Bengal, Sir John Woodburn, Lieutenant Governor of Bengal, and the Maharaja of Kooch Behar.

6. The Institution was first established in an old house on the site of the present building. The increase of students necessitated the addition of another house at 45, Beniatolah Lane. These two houses were offered for sale, and the Institution was threatened with extinction, as no suitable building was available in the neighbourhood. At last the old house at 13, Mirzapore Street was purchased and the present new Building was erected in its place at a cost of about a lac of rupees, a part of which was raised by subscription. In December 1884. Lord Ripon opened the new Building, the foundation stone of which had been laid by the late Sir Rames Chandra Mitra K. T. B. L., the then officiating Chief Justice of the Calcutta High Court. This, we believe was a unique occasion, as, so far as we are aware,

no other Educational Building has had the privilege of being opened by a Viceroy. Lord Ripon's speech on the occasion as well as a few short extracts from other remarks relative to the College are given in Appendix E. The Annual Prize Distribution was presided over by such eminent men, amongst others, as Sir C. U. Aitchison, K. C. S. I. L. L. D., Hon'ble C. P. Ilbert, Hon'ble W. W. Hunter K. C. S. I. L. L. D., Sir Stuart Bayley, Dr. Mahendra Lal Sircar C. I. E. and Sir Alexander Mackenzie. K. C. S. I.

8. There are two Branch Schools which teach up to the

Entrance Standard—one, at Mymensing, called the City Collegiate School, Mymensing Branch, established in January 1883; has shewn very good results year after year,—another at the Northern part of the town, called City Collegiate School, Sabha Bazar branch, which was established, in 1885. In addition to these there has been established a Second Grade College at Mymensing as a Branch of the City College since 1901. The total number receiving instruction in the Institution with its Branches exceeds 2000.

9. Special care has been taken for the moral education of the students. Besides special instruction in moral and religious subjects on particular days, there is a society called Asabahini (or the Band of Hope) whose motto is the following Sanskrit Stanza :—

“शुक्रभक्तिर्दयामैत्री शौचमुद्यमशीलता ।  
 तथैवावासनकाशावाहित्रा लक्षणानि हि ॥”

which means Reverence, Mercy, Love, Purity, Diligence, and Temperance. Its results have been hopeful.

10. To make the education of boys varied and comprehensive special classes have been held in Music, Drawing, Carpentry, and Gymnastics, &c. The boys for their own improvement have formed literary clubs in connection with the College as well as the School classes, and have secured a portion of the Marcus Square for sporting purposes. They also have met from time to time in friendly gatherings for re-unions, friendly intercourse, or enjoyment of innocent amusements.

11. Several useful institutions originated and were fostered at the City College Buildings, among which may be mentioned the Calcutta Deaf and Dumb School, the Anath Bandhu Samiti, the Central Bengal Union, and Dr. M. M. Bose's Homœopathic Institution. Its Hall and rooms as well as furniture have been freely given to the managers of different Societies and Clubs for the improvement of students

or advancement of the cause of religious, moral or social reform, for holding their anniversaries and ordinary meetings.

12. Our today's meeting is a meeting of thanksgivings. We offer our heartfelt thanks to the Dispenser of all good for the blessings, He has showered on this Institution, which enabled it to pass twenty five years of its existence and bear the good fruits briefly mentioned in this report. We also convey our best thanks to those Professors and teachers of the Institution who by their energy, zeal and devotion have materially furthered its progress. Our best thanks are also due to the subscribers and donors to the Building Fund of the College, the guardians of the students, and other friends who in various ways have promoted the welfare of the Institution.

## APPENDIX D.

### Speech of Lord Ripon on the occasion of the opening of the City College Building and Opinions of the Heads of Government, University and Education Department.

---

*Speech of Lord Ripon at the opening of the City College Building  
on the 10th of December, 1884.*

Mr. Rivers Thompson, Ladies and Gentlemen,—It affords me, I assure you, great pleasure to be able to be present upon this interesting occasion and to take part in the opening of these new buildings for the valuable work to which they are about to be devoted. Before I left Calcutta last spring, your President, Mr. Anundo Bose, asked me whether I thought that when I returned to this city, I could undertake the duty of opening these rooms and I then told him that I should gladly do so if it were in my power. I confess, I did not then think, that I should have to perform this work at a time so busy as that at which I am now called upon to discharge it. But in the midst of the many occupations which naturally beset me at the close of my administration, I have felt it a duty, and it certainly is a pleasure, to make an effort to fulfil the undertaking which I entered into with your President some months ago, and I can assure you that I have derived great gratification from the hearty welcome which you have given me to-day, from listening to the remarks which have been made as to the purposes and objects of this institution, and in receiving the cordial and friendly address which has been presented to me by the students. As you remark in your address, I have been desirous throughout my administration to encourage and invite the co-operation of private agency in the work of public education, because, as I have had occasion to say more than once, while I am convinced that such co-operation of public and private agencies in this

great and important work is of the utmost value in all countries, I am sure that it is a necessity in India, where the means at the disposal of the Government are so limited, and where consequently they have no alternative but to have recourse to private munificence, and to that private munificence we have not appealed in vain. I see he to-day not a few distinguished men who have done good work in the direction, and I heartily congratulate you, gentlemen, who are connected with the management of this institution, upon the share which you have had in that noble work. Your President has described to us the progress which the institution has made, and very remarkable that progress seems to me to have been. Founded not much more than five years ago, it has grown, as he has told us, from a first-class English school into a first-grade college teaching the full Arts course; and surely here we find ample proof, if proof were wanted, of what may be accomplished by private efforts in the matter of education (Cheers). And while I heartily wish every possible success to the City College, I hope that throughout India other men will be found to imitate the work which is here so successfully being done by those who conduct this institution. (Hear, hear). The President has, in his remark, alluded to some of the distinguishing features of this College, and there is one of them especially on which I am desirous of saying a few words to-day. Mr. Anundo Bose has reminded us that in this College an effort and a successful one has been made to combine moral with intellectual training. I have had occasion to say, more than once since I came to this country, how deep is my conviction, that the union of moral and intellectual training is essential to complete education (Cheers). I attach to that union the very greatest importance. I rejoice at the effort which is here being made to perfect and carry out this attempt, and I trust that it will be followed in many other directions by other institutions (Applause). Gentlemen, the Government of India had recently to consider a question connected with this very subject. As many of you are aware, a wish was expressed in the Report of the Education Commission, of which my friend, Mr. Bose, was a distinguished and valued member, that the Government should take steps for the purpose of issuing for use in colleges a work of the nature of a moral text-book. I hope that it

is needless for me to say that if we found ourselves unable to give effect to the proposal, it was not from any indifference on the part of any member of the Government to the importance of the moral education of the people of this country. But the Government of India stand in circumstances very special in regard to the matter. We are bound even to raise the faintest suspicion that under the cover of any measure which we may take, we are desirous of showing favor to any particular creed in this country. However strong may be our individual religious convictions, as a Government we are constitutionally bound to preserve perfect neutrality in that respect (Cheers); and we felt we should only run the risk of injuring a great object, which might be pursued by other means, if by interfering in the matter ourselves, and as it might be out-running public opinion upon the subject, we were to give rise to any misconceptions or misrepresentations as to the intentions of the Government. Therefore we did not find ourselves able to act on that recommendation of the Commission. But, gentlemen, what in the peculiar circumstances of India, the Government could not do, can be done by private agency. Where we are bound to proceed with the utmost caution, you can come forward freely, and advance with boldness, and you may in this respect not merely do a great work yourselves, but you may show the way to the Government hereafter, because, by the success of your efforts, you may prove what can be done in this respect with the general consent of public opinion (Cheers). I was very glad to learn that amongst the other special features of this College, is the establishment of a carpentry class; because, small though the beginning is, we may find there, as Mr. Anundo Mohun Bose said, a forward step in the direction of technical education. I wish that it had been in my power, that I had time and opportunity, while connected with the administration of this country, to take some steps in that most important direction. I rejoice to see that it has already been brought under the notice of my noble friend, Lord Dufferin, and that he has spoken of his interest in it, in a manner such as we should expect from one of his well-known sentiments and feelings (Applause). I trust that it will be one of the questions which will engage his early attention; and I am confident that it is one, which, if he can solve it,

will confer great benefit upon such a country (Cheers). And, gentlemen, I look also with gratification upon the existence of such a class in this College, because it seems to me to bear witness to the true dignity of labour—a lesson, which I believe, it is of the greater importance to impress upon public opinion in this country. But when you deal with the great subject like intellectual, moral, technical education, you have not overlooked minor matters. And you have, I am glad to see, considered the development of the body, as well as the development of the mind, and have also had lectures upon most important questions connected with the preservation of health, and on sanitary subjects.

Gentlemen, I can only repeat the pleasure with which I have taken part in these proceedings to-day; and in declaring these new buildings open for use of the City College, I can assure you that I shall watch with sincere interest the progress of this institution even from my western home (Loud cheers), and I trust that these halls may, for many long years to come, be filled with an ever-growing number of students, eager to avail themselves to the utmost, of the full benefits which this institution offers to them, and determined to use the instruction which they will here receive to the honour of that God Who embraces in His wide-reaching love men of all races and of all climes, (Cheers) and Who has entrusted rich gifts of intellect and of character to His children that they may employ them in His service, and for the good of their fellowmen (Loud cheers). Mr. Rivers Thompson, and gentlemen, I now declare this building to be open for the purposes of instruction. (Cheers.)

*Extracts from the speech of the Hon'ble C. P. Ilbert, Vice-Chancellor  
of the Calcutta University, delivered on the occasion of the  
Distribution of Prizes of the City College,  
on the 17th of January, 1886.*

Especially am I glad to make myself acquainted with an institution like yours which presents a type to which it is very probable that most of the Bengal colleges of the future will ultimately conform. It is to the special character of the constitution of this institution that you owe the honour which was done you by the late Viceroy

when he attended in person to open your new buildings a year ago. During the very last days of his term of office, the very busiest time of his whole official career, when his whole time was absorbed by delicate and weighty offices of state, when his whole energies were concentrated in the problem of handing over to his successor the vast task of governing this mighty empire, he found, or rather made, leisure to testify by his presence to the interest which he took in the welfare of your institution; and why did he do so? Because deeply as he was interested in all forms and phases of Indian education, that form attracted him most and enlisted his sympathy most strongly, and seemed to him most full of hopeful augury for the future, which relied not on government machinery or foreign assistance, but on independent effort and native unofficial management, which rested on a knowledge by the people of the country of their own proper needs, and a vigorous determination on their part to supply those needs for themselves if by any means they might.

Self-support, unofficial management, native agency, these, as I understand, are the three cardinal principles of the City College and if you succeed, as I fervently hope you may, in conducting it on these principles, you will go far towards solving one of the most difficult problems of Indian education.

*Extracts from the speech of the Hon'ble Sir W. W. Hunter, K.C.S.I.,  
L.L.D., Vice-Chancellor of the Calcutta University, on the  
occasion of the Distribution of Prizes of the  
City College on the 21st January, 1887.*

The City College has correctly understood what are the principles of true development and progress, and it has acted on them. It would have rejoiced the heart of the late Viceroy, whose portrait looks down from the wall, could he have been present in person and seen this enormous and spacious hall overflowing to the doors, and with half the students left outside, and to have known how this great work has been accomplished.

The history of this institution struck me not only as a wonderful example of progress, but also of temperance of aim. It started with a comparatively elementary standard. In two years it advanced to a higher standard. Two years more and students were being sent for the University B. L. Examination. It was again two years before it found itself able to teach up to the B. A. The result is that this year you not only send students who pass successfully in B. A. and M. A. Examinations, but that they hold the first place in the University lists.

I was struck by the reference your Principal made to the burden of debt, from which it is essential that the institution should be released. You have at a large outlay built this great edifice and I sincerely hope that the burden of debt will be taken off the shoulders of the Committee by the wealthy public.

As President of the Education Commission I had to give expression to Lord Ripon's measures of reform in that department. I believe that the work which Lord Ripon began, and of which this institution is an example, is the best way to educate India, and that the Government institutions will in the future be swallowed up by independent colleges like this. I look upon the work done by yourselves as more lasting than the work which the Government can do for you.

I feel that this institution has done good in the past and that it will do good in the future. I hope it will be liberally supported by the native princes and landholders, and merchants.

*Extracts from the speech of Hon<sup>ble</sup> Sir C. U. Aitchison K.C.S.I., L.L.D.,  
on the occasion of the Distribution of Prizes of the  
City College on the 21st January, 1888.*

Until the Managing Council did me the honour of asking me to preside on this occasion, I had not informed myself of the important educational movement in Calcutta of which this College is the visible expression; and on seeking to acquaint myself with the facts,

I was more than agreeably surprised at the degree of success which has attended it. Certainly it is a matter of no small significance that, within ten years, a school beginning in a humble way should have developed into a College such as this, training men with success for high literary degrees, attended by some 300 students and with Branch Schools under it, educating more than 1700 scholars. Evidently that all this should have been done by unaided self-effort, without any subsidy from the State, without direction of the Education Department, and without the control of Government, is to me a unique experience, and something very different from what I have been accustomed to in other parts of India with which I am better acquainted.

In listening to the Report which has been laid before us and in reading the Reports of previous years, I have been struck by the business-like way in which things seem to be managed. You have your Managing Committee for the conduct of current affairs. The efficiency of your teaching staff is evidenced by the results of the examinations. Your moral and religious teaching supplements the one great defect in the official system of education, and you have in your cricket club and gymnastic classes arrangements for physical training—all these circumstances, which greatly add to the satisfaction I have in presiding on this occasion, may be taken I hope as evidence that this institution meets a real want and that the movement is not spasmodic, but likely to be well-sustained and permanent. \* \* \*

*Extracts from the speech of His Honor Sir Stuart Bayley delivered on the occasion of the Distribution of Prizes of the City College on the 18th April, 1889.*

I was greatly struck in listening to the report at the exceedingly rapid growth of this institution. Founded ten years ago as a high school, it grew in two years' time into a second class college. Then its law side developed largely, and finally after a brief existence of five years it became a fully developed college, teaching up to the



A. degree, with the large number of 317 undergraduates in the college department while in all its branches it has over 1,000 students on its rolls. Its success in examinations has not been less marked than the capacity of its growth. Your percentage of passes and their position in the list has equalled that of any of the paid colleges. It bids fair to compete with that of the Presidency. For all this

Council and teachers deserve the highest praise, and specially those who have, like my friend Dr. Gooroo Dass Banerjee, devoted their time and talents to the work.

You say your object is "to widen the basis of education by inducing the pupils to cultivate all their faculties," and if I have rightly understood your report, you seek to do this by adding to the ordinary Arts course such objects as gymnastics, drawing, music, arithmetic, and science. You have also a library, a laboratory and a literary club, and above all you devote yourself to moral training, and that both by giving up a specific time to special moral instruction, and also by your professors and teachers in the course of ordinary teaching trying to infuse a moral spirit and elevated tone. I look upon the spirit of your programme as quite the right spirit in which to approach the question of training, and on the work as really one of supreme importance.

*Extracts from the speech of Sir Alexander Mackenzie, K.C.S.I., on the occasion of the Distribution of Prizes at the City College on the 27th March, 1896.*

I congratulate the College and its managers on the very favourable report of progress that has been laid before us. I had my pleasure in accepting your President's invitation to take the chair this occasion, because I recognise in the City College one of the most flourishing of the unaided colleges in Bengal. \* \* \* The City College, as the reports show, now heads the list of colleges in Bengal. \* \* \* I need not recapitulate the figures of the report showing the success of your students in the examinations. It is to me particularly gratifying to observe the attention paid here to the Science Course of the University. The more students that can be turned from purely literary studies to the study of science, the better it will be for Bengal. I have been more interested however in studying the constitution of the college and school than even in noting their progress. I trace in that constitution the hand of an idealist, but of an idealist with lofty aims and practical ends in view. The object of the institution is boldly stated to be to make the education of the boys—comprehending the training of mind, heart, and body, and founded on a theistic but unsectarian basis—conduce to the good of man and the glory of God. That, truly, is a high and noble aim

In conclusion, I wish all prosperity to the college and the school their managers, teachers, and pupils of all grades. I trust that the wonderful success which has attended the work initiated by Mr. Anundo Mohun Bose will stimulate the liberality of the wealthier members of the community to relieve the institution of the debt which still hangs over it, and enable it to prosecute its career of usefulness on an even larger scale than it has at present realised.

A BRIEF REPORT  
OF  
The City College.  
Session, 1903-1904.

---

On the 5th January 1904, this institution completed 25 years of its existence ; and for the celebration of its 25th anniversary a College Reunion was held in the College Hall on the 23rd of January last, when a good number of friends and old students of the College gathered together. Mr. A. M. Bose M. A., President of the City College Council, occupied the chair. The proceedings of the Union consisted of prayers and thanksgiving, songs, action songs, recitations, and a phonographic exhibition. The Secretary gave a brief account of the College from its foundation and of the work done by it as a teaching Institution. The President then gave a suitable address and advised the students present to organize a society with a view to promoting the *esprit de corps* between the old and the existing students and making the Reunion a regular annual institution. A nucleus of the society under the name of "The Old Students' Association of the City College" was then and there formed. The proceedings ended with light refreshments.

**New Constitution.**—The College with all its property has been made over to the Sadharan Brahmo Samaj; and that body, in order to secure the permanence and efficient management of the institution, has resolved to get it registered under Act XXI of 1860 and framed Rules and Regulations for the guidance of the College Council as well as the general management of the College. Some distinguished educationists and scholars have been included in the re-constituted College Council.

**College Building.**—The College building is in good repairs, but still labours under a liability of Rs. 30,000 out of a total cost of about a lac and quarter of Rupees for its construction. The building urgently requires additions as some school classes and the Library are in need of enlarged accommodation.

**Numerical Strength.**—The College shews improvement in respect of its numerical strength which owing to various circumstances had fallen off for some time. The number which had gone down to 930 in 1902, rose to 1030 in 1903, and has in the present year come up to 1103. The Mymensing Branch is in a flourishing condition and shews increased strength. The Sobhabazar Branch had to be transferred permanently to other hands owing to unforeseen circumstances.

C. De—Drawing Master. It is a matter of great satisfaction that Babu Heramba Chandra Maitra M. A., its veteran Professor, has rejoined the staff from the beginning of the present session.

The College Department has regular exercises and periodical examinations. In the School Department besides an annual examination, half-

yearly and monthly examinations are regularly held. Monthly statements shewing the attendance, progress, and conduct of the boys are regularly sent to their guardians. The names of the students, entitled to prizes by the results of the last annual examination are given in Appendix A.

**University Examinations.**—The results of the University Examination in the year under report are on the whole satisfactory. 16 passed in the B. L. Examination and 17 in the B. A. Examination, of whom Nava Gouranga Basakh obtained double Honours—1st class Honours in Mathematics and 2nd Class in Physical Science. Another student named Sati Prasad Ganguli obtained Honours in English. In the F. A. Examination 20 passed, of whom 1 was placed in the 1st, 6 in the 2nd, and the rest in the 3rd Division. In the Entrance Examination 15 passed, of whom 4 were placed in the 1st, 4 in the 2nd and the rest in the 3rd Division, of these Debansu Nath Chackerburty has secured a junior Government Scholarship. (Vide Appendix B.)

Of the College scholarships reserved for meritorious students a monthly stipend of Rs. 30 has been conferred on Naba Gouranga Basakh of the M. A. Class and of Rs. 5 on Karunamay Ray of the 3rd Year Class.

**Special Classes.**—Rudimentary Science is taught to all the School Classes. Drawing and Drill are taught to the students after School hours.

**Physical Exercise.**—Our students regularly play in the Marcus Square, where a plot of ground has been secured for them, for which a monthly subscription of Rs. 5 is paid.

**Moral Teaching.**—Moral training has been a special feature of the institution from the beginning of its existence. Moral instruction is regularly given to all the School Classes in special hours reserved for the purpose. Religious and moral lectures are occasionally given to the College Classes. The Band of Hope has been formed for the further promotion of this object. Thanks are due to the members of the Metropolitan Temperance and Purity Association for helping the work of the institution in this respect.

**Students' Club.**—The Students of the College and School Departments have clubs for literary and moral culture.

The Old College Council will retire as soon as the new Council formed under the new constitution take their place. They have to thank the public generally for the help they have rendered to the College so long, and specially the donors who contributed to the College Funds. They earnestly hope that the Providence which has for the last 25 years helped the maintenance and growth of the City College will give it new life and vigour to carry on its work in the future.
