• **Report of Excursion :**

We visited Asutosh Museum of Indian Art in University of Calcutta, College Street, Kolkata on 22/03/2024. We went with our Semester I (IDC) Sanskrit, Semester IV and Semester VI students for some knowledge of Ancient Indian Art and Craft.

Asutosh Museum has a unique assemblage of most of the ancient pottery collection which is carried our Bengal tradition. It is situated in Chadraketugarh, South 24 Parganas. Also there are available ancient Indian Buddha incarnation statues various era and those are collected from many areas and many states. Also there are Nabagraha statues which is used in ancient time for counting month, day etc. There are available ancient hand craft stone and pottery jewellery. Also There available so many various painting which is famous for West Bengal Like - Kalighata Painting , Patachitra, Nakshi kantha, Sara painting, Daker Saj of Durga Idol with Sola, Wooden Craft, Color painting Manuscript and miniature Painting , Saree collection (Baluchory, Dhakai Moslin, Tusser silk) , Bamboo hand craft which is made by Tribble community (Mahali, Purulia District) Ivory Craft etc. Al above the things related our syllabus – Sculptures, Manuscript, Painting, hand craft everything related our Semester I (IDC Paper), Semester IV and VI.
