In Sanskrit literature has many branches like Vedic Literature, Classical literature, Medical Science, Philosophy etc. In present time has written many Sanskrit books. By reading the literature, we can improve our knowledge and can apply it to our daily life.
- **BRIEF REPORT** - State Level multilingual language group Seminar on relevance of Literature Hindi, Bengali, Sanskrit & English Department of City College, Kolkata has organised a State Level Seminar in collaboration with IQAC on the relevance of Literature on 19th September 2022. The seminar was inaugurated by Dr Pampa Guha. Dr. Mahitosh Gayen, the Vice Principal of City College deliberated welcome lecture. After that IQAC Coordinator Dr. Arnab Choudhury made his statement there. Hindi Seminar was conducted by Prof. Sandip Prasad of Hindi Department. Prof. Sandip Prasad discussed about the utility of learning Hindi and the reason behind it. Chief Speaker of Hindi Language Dr. Suresh Lohar discussed about the relativity of Hindi Language. He also discussed about the relation between the Author Reader and Society. He said that literature not only gives pleasure, it expresses sorrows also. It helps to make a good society. Dr. Omprakash Rabidas, the President talked about the utility of learning Hindi. Dr. Sanat Kumar Naskar, the chief Speaker of Bengali, practised literature from various aspects. He said nowadays people are not interested in book reading due to various types of amusement in modern technology. But books are very much informative. So we will become enriched if we have practice in book reading. Dr. Anirban Manna also admitted that literature enriches us as well as our society. Sanskrit Speaker Dr. Sudipa Bandyopadhyay spoke

regarding women power in Vedic language and Epic literature. She told that in ancient time, women used to take active role, which is mentioned in Veda, Upanisad, Samhita, Brahman, Epic etc. At that time, Women were very much involved in various aspects like Science, warfare, economy, service, treatment etc. Dr. Madhumita Deb Roy Barman, the President of Sanskrit seminar, also was also agreed with the speaker's view and pointed out about that. The English speaker Dr. Joydip Sarangi admitted about the greatness of English Literature. He told we can know the internal matters by translating foreign language. The pride of our society and culture is revealed upon strong base in internal aspect by the English authors from Indian background as well as English translation of Indian literature.
