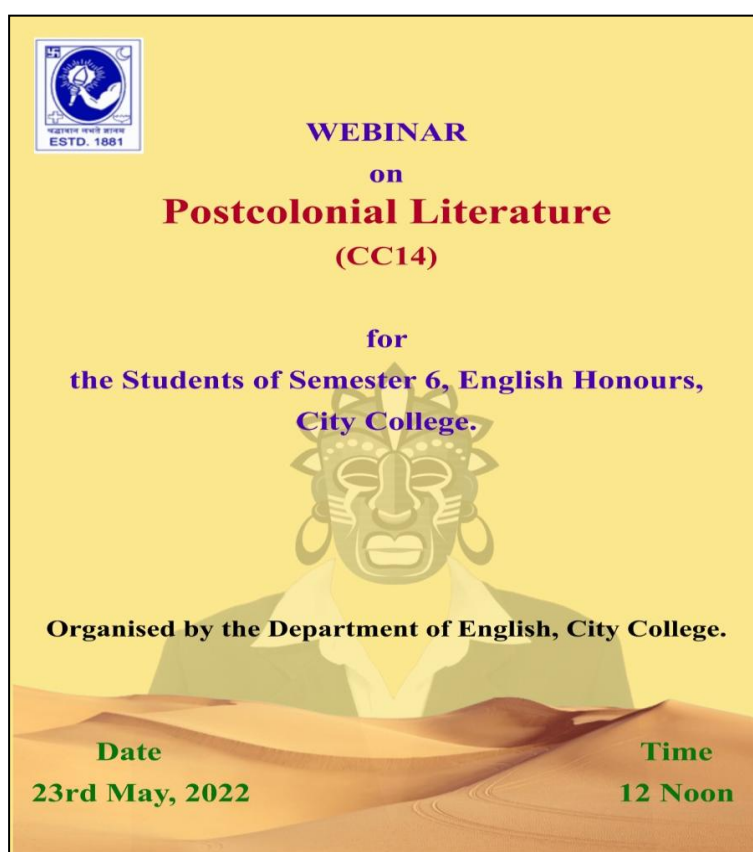
Webinar on Postcolonial Literature
