## Minutes of the Meeting Held on 30.08.2024

### Discussion on Agenda 1 -

Thorough discussion was held on the requirement for sanitary napkin vending machine, that was decided to be placed in the last meeting held on 19.07.2024. All members present strongly supported and agreed for its immediate installation.

In the meeting, present members searched for different types of machines and enquired with different companies. Advantage, disadvantage and costs of machine of different companies were thoroughly discussed. Few companies were listed for asking quotation.

Members also discussed about the installation place. The members physically searched for suitable places including all ladies washrooms, staffroom, corridors etc. Ultimately the corner of South-west of Room No. N5 in 2nd floor was selected, for installation of the Machine at present, that is easily accessible to Ladies Washroom.

Matter regarding vending machine company and installation place was informed to the Principal, who asked the convenor for collection of quotations from the respective companies.

### Discussion on Agenda 2 -

Discussion continued on the second agenda. Different opinions were raised on the matter. Student representatives strongly agreed for conducting rally on human chain to raise voice against social violence, which was announced to be conducted as rally from college main gate to Vivekananda Road crossing through Raja Rammohan Sarani but could not be arranged due to water logging caused by heavy rain. Other members also agreed for rearranging the rally. After some discussion, it was decided to take a second attempt for arranging human chain along the adjacent footpath of the college on 4th September around 3pm. The arrangement is subjected to weather conditions. Student representatives were requested to inform student participants to make the rally successful.
